## Volume I: Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart

Discover the world of Mozart's time...what life was like for this brilliant musician, both personally and professionally. His astonishingly prolific and creative works defined the Classical era of European music. ## Volume IV: George Gershwin

These beloved pieces are performed by Dennis Kobray in this energetic portrayal of one of America's most treasured musicians.

## Volume II: Ludwig Van Beethoven

## Volume V: Johann Sebastian Bach

Johann Sebastian Bach was the personification of the Baroque style - a music that was complex and highly embellished. He drew from many sources and produced a vast body of work, steeped in the flavor of the period, yet belonging to all time. Dennis Kobray brings this magnificent eighteenth century composer to life with exuberant performances of Bach's masterpieces on the clavichord, harpsichord and grand piano.

## Volume III: Scott Joplin

In 1973, audiences for the film *The Sting* left theaters humming the effervescent music of Scott Joplin. A love of ragtime, revived in the mid-70s, continues to this day. Discover what life was like for an African-American musician at the turn of the twentieth century. Dennis Kobray portrays a friend and fan of Scott Joplin, whose *Maple Leaf Rag* and *The Entertainer* earned him the title of the "King of Ragtime."
